Gentlemen:

As a result of recently completed studies, Company proposes the uprating of Midway and Tesla Substations as follows:

Midway Substation

Due to increased switching center duties, Company proposes to rerate this station from Schedule I at \$140.65 per week to \$143.40 per week.

Tesla Substation

Due to 220 Kv equipment additions, Company proposes to rerate this station from Schedule III at \$130.20 per week to Schedule II at \$136.90 per week.

It is further proposed these reratings be effective on October 21, 1962.
