Gentlemen:

Company has recently completed a survey of the duties assigned to the dual classification of Meter Repairman/Chartman in the Gas Department at Marysville. This classification is currently held by Mr. F. J. Newbold. Mr. Newbold is regularly assigned to work Wednesday through Sunday performing the following duties:

Wednesday and Thursday - routine repairs to regulators and minor repairs to gas meters.

Friday - changing those charts in the area which have to be changed once a week.

Saturday and Sunday - changing daily charts in the gas fields and answering service calls.

Company proposes that Mr. Newbold's classifications be changed to Utility Serviceman with the following Job Definitions:

Utility Serviceman - Gas Service Department - Marysville

An employee who performs the duties of a Serviceman in the Gas Service Department and, in addition, performs the duties of a Chartman, repairs regulators and makes minor repairs to gas meters.

The employee in this classification will receive the wage rate of, and accrue classification seniority as, a Serviceman in the Gas Service Department.
