Company has recently re-surveyed the responsibilities and duties of the First Operator classification at Pittsburg Switching Station. The addition of Unit 5 to Pittsburg Power Plant, and the contemplated addition of Unit 6, in our opinion, increase the responsibilities of this classification to the point where they are comparable to those of the First Operator classification in other substations in Schedule I.

Company therefore proposes to increase the wage rate of the First Operator classification at Pittsburg Switching Station from Schedule II - \$125.90 per week to Schedule I - \$129.65 per week.
