Since May 14, 1951, Mr. O. Dale has held the classification of Maintenance Subforeman in the Electric Transmission and Distribution Department at Bakersfield.

As Maintenance Subforeman, Mr. Dale has performed the duties outlined in the Job Definition of the Line Subforeman classification.

Company will eliminate the classification of Maintenance Subforeman in the Electric Transmission and Distribution Department and, under the provisions of Subsection 206.1(e) of the Agreement, proposes to reclassify Mr. Dale to Line Subforeman without reference to the bidding procedure, to be effective on November 1, 1964.

The weekly wage rate that has been applied to the Maintenance Subforeman classification is identical to that of the Line Subforeman classification and Company proposes to place Mr. Dale at the one-year wage step (\$170.35 per week) which results in no wage rate change.

Company further proposes that time worked by Mr. Dale in the Maintenance Subforeman classification be credited as time worked in the Line Subforeman classification.
