Dear Mr. Dalzell:

West Sacramento RMC Operating Clerk Jonathan Grind has requested, due to family issues, to be temporarily assigned to a location closer to his family in the greater Los Angeles area. The Company is willing to accommodate this request by temporarily assigning Mr. Grind to the Bakersfield Service Center, provided the Company does not incur any costs as a result of this accommodation.

The Company proposes that all temporary headquarter expenses associated with this temporary headquarters be waived. Additionally, Mr. Grind will not be entitled to travel time associated with overtime assignments while assigned to this temporary headquarters.

The temporary headquarter assignment will commence as soon as practicable following the execution of this letter agreement. It is expected to last approximately three to six months, but may end sooner at Company's discretion.

The Company has discussed this proposal with Business Representatives Arlene Edwards and Bob Dean.
