Gentlemen:

Our proposed letter agreement dated September 19, 1958, is hereby withdrawn.

The wage rate of \$96.05 per week for the Utilityman classification in Rio Vista, formerly held by Mr. L. E. Frates, was computed on the basis of the following duties: Transformer Repairman - 5%; Truck Driver, Heavy (Boat Operation) - 15%; Helper - 10%; Garageman - 45%; Groundman - 15%; Laborer - 10%.

Based upon a survey of the anticipated duties of this classification, Company proposes to establish the rate of \$95.85 per week, based on the following breakdown:

Warehouseman	25% of	\$ 97.20 =	\$24.30
Laborer	25% of	84.85 =	21.21
Truck Driver, Heavy (Boat Operation)	25% of	100.40 =	25.10
Service Operator, Senior	10% of	115.50 =	11.55
