Dear Mr. Dalzell:

Pursuant to Section 3.5 of the Physical Agreement, Company proposes to waive the 30 minute automotive travel time requirement for Mr. Dennis Campbell, Gas Service Representative (GSR) headquartered in Sacramento. for the following reason.

Mr. Campbell was a GSR in the Sacramento headquarters from 1993 to 2000. In 2000 he accepted a job as a Dispatcher in Sacramento, but was displaced from this dispatch position in 2006. During the 2006 displacement, he accepted a job as a Meter Reader. In 2010, as a concern for the displacement of his Meter Reader position, he accepted a job bid back to a GSR position in the Sacramento headquarters

Mr. Campbell still lives in the same residence from 2000 when he was a GSR in Sacramento, and met the requirements of Section 3.5. Over the years, the commute patterns have changed, and currently he is approximately 34 minutes from this Sacramento headquarters. This waiver is limited to Mr. Campbell's current residence and the Sacramento Service Center. Should Mr. Campbell relocate his residence or bid another headquarters, he will be expected to meet the residency requirement.

This proposal has been discussed with Bryan Carroll, local Business Representative.
