Company intends to reclassify the Ditch Patrolman position at Colfax, currently assigned Mr. Harvey G. Miller, and the Ditch Patrolman position at Alta, currently assigned Mr. George M. The incumbent employees perform all duties of the Ditch Tender classification and are now furnishing their own housing since they are no longer required to live adjacent to the canal.

Company proposes, pursuant to Sections 205.19 and 206.13 of the Physical Agreement, to assign the above mentioned employees to the Ditch Tender classification.
