Gentlemen:

Company intends to separate the Division Electric Meter Shop work from field meter work in East Bay Division. At present, Senior Metermen assigned to the Division Meter Shop are performing field work in Central District. All other districts in the Division have Senior Metermen for their district field work. Accordingly, Company intends to transfer four Senior Metermen positions from the Division Electric Meter Shop at San Leandro to the Central District Electric Department at Oakport.

Pursuant to Sections 205.19 and 206.13, Company proposes to assign the following Senior Metermen to the Oakport headquarters, provisions of Title 205 to the contrary notwithstanding:

Company further proposes that each of the above employees retain the right to return to the San Leandro headquarters in accordance with provisions of Title 206, "Demotion and Lay Off Procedure," of the Physical Agreement.
