Gentlemen:

During the past fourteen months, Mr. Herb Lewis, Street Light Maintenance Man in Santa Rosa, has provided the Company with letters from his doctor stating that because of severe knee problems he could no longer perform the normal duties of the Street Light Maintenance Man classification. Mr. Lewis's knee problem has been diagnosed as a degenerative arthritis of the right knee. According to Mr. Lewis's physician, Mr. Lewis should not climb in and out of a truck with repetitive steps; he should not work out of an aerial bucket which requires climbing up four steps, in and out of the bucket approximately thirty-five times a day; and he should not operate a heavy-duty vehicle because of a problem in applying the brakes.

Therefore, Company proposes, pursuant to Sections 205.19 and 206.13 of the Physical Agreement, to place Mr. Lewis into a Transformer Repairman classification in Santa Rosa.
