In order to reflect the changes brought about as a result of the 1974 General Negotiations, Company proposes the following changes in the Master Apprenticeship Agreement:

- 1. Section D should read: A bid made by a journeyman to fill a job vacancy in an apprentice classification of his own normal Line of Progression shall neither receive preferential consideration under the provisions of Subsections 205.7 (b), (c) or (d) nor 205.8 (b), (c) or (d) of the Agreement.
- 2. In filling journeyman vacancies under Section J, all mention of apprentice classification seniority shall be amended to read employment date.
