Dear Mr. Dalzell:

Jeremy Hayes is a Title 200 Apprentice Electrical Technician headquartered at the Auberry Service Center. Prior to bidding to the Auberry Service Center as a T200 Apprentice Electrical Technician effective June 6, 2011, Mr. Hayes was a T200 Electrical Machinist at the Burney Service Center. Under the provisions of the Division Master Apprenticeship Agreement (MAA) Section F.10.c., Mr. Hayes is required to spend one year at the beginning wage rate of Apprentice Electrical Technician classification.

On August 12, 2011, in Apprentice Committee Decision Number AUG-11-24, the Joint Apprenticeship Training Committee, at the request of both the Company and the Union, approved waiving the provisions of the MAA F.10.c. retroactive to June 6, 2011.

Based on Mr. Hayes' journeyman Electrical Machinist experience, and at the request of his department, the Company proposes Mr. Hayes be allowed to maintain his journeyman Electrical Machinist wage rate retroactive to June 6, 2011 and receive no progressive wage increases until such time as his progression through this technical apprenticeship training program merits a wage higher than his current rate.
