Gentlemen:

This cancels and supersedes our proposal to you dated August 10, 1964, on this same subject.

Company is transferring the meter setting functions presently performed by employees in the Electric Underground Department in San Francisco Division to the Electric Meter Department. This will involve the transfer of one Electric Subforeman and six Electricians in the San Francisco Electric Underground Department to Meter Subforeman and Senior Meterman, respectively.

To accomplish this, Company proposes, under the provisions of Section 206.1, to transfer Mr. J. Tolliday to Meter Subforeman and the six Electricians with the most classification seniority, who indicate a preference for such transfer, to Senior Meterman. The employees transferred will not be considered qualified to bid on Senior Meterman classifications elsewhere or to Meter Subforeman, other than in the meter setting group, until they have successfully completed a training course in meter testing which will be offered to them.

If you are in accord with the foregoing proposal and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided below and return one executed copy of this letter to Company.
