In accordance with Section 111.15 of the IBEW Physical Agreement, this letter is to request your agreement to allow IBEW-represented employee, John Barnachia, to voluntarily sell accrued vacation.

Mr. Barnachia is an Apprentice Lineman headquartered in Wasco. He was recently notified of a substantial overpayment in his wages. As a result, he has requested the opportunity to sell vacation in order to help repay the Company for the overpayments received. This agreement would provide that Mr. Barnachia could sell the number of vacation hours sufficient to pay off the unpaid balance of overpayment, not to exceed 180 hours.
