On October 30, 2012, PG&E deployed 90 Lineman, 20 T-Men and 5 Field Clerks to New York at the request of Con Ed for mutual aid and assistance in restoring thousands of customers who are out of service due to Hurricane Sandy.

Pursuant to Section 102.8 of the Physical Agreement, Company proposes to modify the provisions of Section 102.3 of the Physical Agreement regarding the time limits on filing grievances. Company will accept grievances filed within 30 days of these employees' return to the PG&E service territory, as long as the grievance was first stepped with a PG&E supervisor in New York in a timely manner. This will allow employees to focus their efforts on restoring service to customers instead of trying to contact a Local 1245 Business Representative in California.
