Dear Mr. Dalzell:

The Company proposes to continue the temporary use of contractors signatory to IBEW Local 1245, as previously agreed to in LA 12-54, to supplement the Locate and Mark (L&M) workforce through May 31, 2013. As agreed to in LA 12-54, the Company has shared its Gas Operations hiring plan which includes the addition of 400 IBEW-represented positions in 2013 to address staffing shortfalls.

The parties recognizes that leak survey work is not "peak" work as referenced in Letter Agreement 09-41, however agree to temporarily utilize contractors to supplement the L&M workforce due to on-going turnover levels and the need to meet requested customer timelines.

The Company will offer Gas T&D employees who are OQ in Locate & Mark duties a minimum of 20% overtime while contractors are working in their headquarters and/or service territory.

This proposal has been discussed with Assistant Business Manager Joe Osterlund.
