Dear Mr. Dalzell:

The Gas Operations Department has identified an opportunity to maintain and transition certain existing Hiring Hall GC Installer/Meter Readers to perform Title 300 Utility Worker / Flagger work during an interim period pending the outcome of the Gas Service Line of Progression ratification vote. In addition to the conditions outlined in the Gas Service Letter of Agreement R1-14-17 which is pending ratification, this transitional period and continuity of this population supports the Company's longer-term interest in expanding the traffic control resource pool pending completion of a staffing plan.

The selected HH GC Installer/Meter Reader population will be trained and certified to perform traffic control responsibilities and are expected to transition to the Hiring Hall Utility Worker assignments in early June. Those that transition to the temporary HH Utility Worker assignment will be paid the appropriate HH Utility Worker rate consistent with LA R1-04-12.

In addition to the qualified and selected HH Installer / Meter Readers identified for the transition, un-dispatched HH Utility Workers certified to perform traffic control duties by the Union that meet other Company qualifications, shall be identified and offered dispatch opportunities as part to this agreement.

While a specific time period for this temporary HH Utility Worker assignment has not been determined, the affected hiring hall employees have been informed of the potential opportunity to move to a Utility Gas Service Representative classification sometime following an assumed ratification of LA R1-14-17 and implementation of the agreement.
