Gentlemen:

Company proposes that the Gas Serviceman in San Jose Division may be assigned to replace 2-wire A base meters under the following conditions:

1. That other Gas Serviceman duties are not available to be performed by the Gas Serviceman who is given the assignment of performing such meter changes.
2. That such meter replacements are made only on those installations where the main service switch (or other disconnect means) is ahead of the A base meter, thereby permitting such work to be performed under de-energized conditions.
3. That any Gas Serviceman who is assigned to such meter replacement will first be given training and instruction on the procedure to be followed.
4. That such assignment to Gas Servicemen of replacement of such meters be discontinued not later than December 1, 1967.
