Gentlemen:

Company and Union have recently discussed the rate per mile paid to employees under the provisions of Section 301.11 of the Agreement. Company has reviewed this matter and proposes to increase the mileage allowance from 3¢ to $3\frac{1}{2}$ ¢ per mile in accordance with the following:

For the purpose of reimbursement of transportation expense at the minimum common carrier rate as provided for in Section 301.11, employees shall be reimbursed at the rate of 31¢ per mile for such travel over the normally traveled route between their present headquarters and the new headquarters except where the employee travels by bus or other previously authorized common carrier, in which event the employee shall be reimbursed the actual fare established therefor by said common carrier and paid by the employee.
