Dear Mr. Dalzell:

The Company and Union have been in discussions regarding the Meteorological Instrumentperson (MI)(SAP 50010232) line of progression and the needs of the Company to ensure that they have the proper training and qualifications to perform all duties as defined in the current job description. The parties have agreed to the following changes:

- After the effective date of this Agreement, all bidders into the MI classification will be required to possess
 the craft qualifications of a journeyman Water Systems Repairperson (WSR), defined as having
 successfully completed the WSR apprenticeship. Currently there are incumbent WSR's that did not
 complete the WSR apprenticeship, these incumbents will be deemed qualified.
- All MI's will be required to possess and maintain a class A driver's license.
- MI's will be paid the same hourly rate as WSR's.
- The single incumbent MI, Robert Hammill will not be required to obtain a class A driver's license but will be required to maintain his class B license. Additionally, he will be considered qualified to bid MI positions.
- The Assistant Meteorological Instrumentperson classification (AIM)(SAP50070773) will be eliminated.

<u>METEOROLOGICAL INSTRUMENTPERSON</u> 1036 (50010232)

An employee who, without direct supervision, is engaged in the installation, operation, and maintenance of equipment associated with the cloud seeding, precipitation, surface wind, temperature, and upper air sounding systems. Such employee routinely performs duties, such as installation and removal of silver iodide generator equipment and precipitation gauges; services and makes repairs to the equipment as required; adjusts and calibrates gauges and recorders; changes charts; and maintains records. During storm periods, operates the upper air sounding system, reducing data and submitting to the weather office. Is responsible for maintaining adequate supplies to operate the project and may be called on from time to time to perform special studies in the field, such as collecting snow replica slides. Must possess a Class A Driver's License.

In addition, may be required to perform all duties of a Water System Repairperson and be assigned to work on Company's water facilities in the hydro development in the area to which assigned.
