## Gentlemen:

As has been mentioned in earlier informal discussions, Company is planning to move its Accounts Payable Bureau and the related Comptometer and Stenographic Bureau from its Corporate Accounting Department to the General Accounting Department. This change is currently scheduled for August 7, 1967.

Since the employees in the General Accounting Department are represented by Local 1245, I.B.E.W., we propose to include the Accounts Payable Section in the bargaining unit after August 7. Attached is a list of the employees who will be affected along with their classifications as of June 1, and Company employment dates.
