Gentlemen:

This letter replaces and rescinds the letter to you on this subject dated December 27, 1962.

Company proposes to establish the classification of Utility Pressure Operator at the San Rafael Gas Load Center. The job definition is as follows:

Utility Pressure Operator - San Rafael

An employee who is an Emergency Relief Pressure Operator and, in addition, may be assigned to assist a journeyman in the performance of gas meter and regulator set fabrication and maintenance of telemetering and control facilities.

This employee will accrue classification seniority as and receive the wage rate of a Pressure Operator.

Company further proposes to place Mr. R. R. McDermott in this classification effective January 14, 1963, without reference to the bidding procedure. Mr. R. R. McDermott is presently classified as Plant Mechanic/Emergency Relief Pressure Operator, a position Company will eliminate.
