Dear Mr.Dean:

Company and Union recently met to discuss the relocation of Service Representative employees who support Contact Center Operations within the San Jose Contact Center. The Company intends to close the San Jose Contact Center no earlier than December 31, 2020.

In accordance with Section 19.12 of the clerical agreement, the Company proposes the following options to address the impacts to affected Contact Center employees headquartered at 111 Almaden Boulevard, San Jose, California:

All IBEW bargaining unit employees within the Contact Center Operations department at the San Jose Contact Center will be given Section 19.1(a) notification as soon as possible, which affords them priority bidding rights ("A" rights). Impacted employees shall be given a displacement option form no less than 30 days prior to the closure and shall be provided a minimum of 14 calendar days to complete the form, indicating their voluntary preferences as follows:

- 1. Accept a position within the same classification at the Fresno Contact Center or Sacramento 2740 Contact Center. Employees who accept this option will remain on their existing shift until the next centerwide shift bid at which time shifts will be awarded based upon headquarters, classification, and seniority.
 - a. For employees who accept this option there will be two possible outcomes:
 - i. Employees who are able to successfully perform their jobs remotely will be allowed to do so through the end of COVID-19 remote working conditions, as determined by the Company, or through December 31, 2021, whichever comes later. The parties are currently discussing an agreement for long term remote working conditions. Should the parties negotiate af uture agreement allowing for long term remote working conditions, the provisions of that Agreement will supersede the terms and conditions of a remote work arrangement as described herein.
 - ii. Employees not able to successfully perform their jobs remotely will be required to report to their newly assigned headquarters, no later than January 31, 2021.
 - b. The Contact Center has temporarily secured a limited number of hotel spaces at 111 Almaden Boulevard through June 30, 2021. The hotel spaces may be used on a temporary basis to accommodate urgent unexpected circumstances, such as, but not limited to Power/Internet Outages, Technology Issues, or PSPS event. Note: There will be no on-sight support for employees temporarily utilizing hotel spaces.
 - i. If an urgent unexpected circumstance arises which prevents the employee from working remotely temporarily, the employee is to contact their immediate supervisor to request use of a hotel space.
 - ii. Employees who report to a hotel space at 111 Almaden Boulevard will not be entitled to travel time, mileage or reimbursement of transportation expenses.

- 2. Placement into an identified entry levelvacancy within the Clerical or Physical bargaining unit. Employees must meet qualification requirements at the time of election, as communicated in the email communication on 12/14/20. Such identified vacancies will be communicated to employees as soon as practicable.
 - a. Impacted employees shall have their wages frozen in accordance with the provisions of Section 13.9(d) of the clerical agreement, following notice of displacement, and who elect to vacate their position through bid, transfer, or election of a position with a lower wage scale.
- 3. Voluntary layoff with severance pay in accordance with Exhibit K and Section 19.7(b).

Impacted employee elections, as outlined in options 1 - 3 above, will be determined by Company seniority for Full Time employees and then by Company seniority for Part Time employees and shall be binding upon notification of awarded election.

The provisions of Section 19.8 Moving Allowance shall apply to this agreement as applicable, and the reimbursement maximum allowed for moving expenses shall be \$5,000 based on submission of qualifying expenses in accordance with this section of the clerical agreement.

Impacted employees will have accelerated Title 18 bidding and transfer rights to the same line of progression vacancies (also known as "A" rights) as outlined in Title 19.9.

The Company and Union will work together to ensure employees are fully informed and educated prior to making their elections. The parties will work together to answer any questions and/or resolve any issues that arise out of this process. Report dates and severance dates will be determined by the Company based on operating need.

This proposal has been discussed with Assistant Business Manager Bryan Carroll and Business Representative Graciela Clark.
