Gentlemen:

This letter cancels and supersedes our letter of December 20, 1974 to you on the same subject.

Subsequent to the revisions in the Materials Distribution classifications which took place on January 31, 1972, the following named individuals in San Francisco Division were placed into the Materials Leadman classification:

Each of these employees does not possess a Class I driver's license which is a requirement of the Materials Leadman classification. The waiver of this requirement was not sought at the time these job awards were made. However, since the Division does not require these individuals to drive a vehicle requiring a Class I driver's license, Company proposes, pursuant to Sections 205.19 and 206.13 of the Physical Agreement, to waive the licensing requirement. Company further proposes that each of the employees mentioned above must possess the Class I license prior to filling a Materials Leadman position in any other Division on the Company system, except where such requirement is waived by agreement between Company and Union.
