Gentlemen:

Due to problems encountered with various Service Agreements with vendors and local agents concerning maintenance of certain equipment in the Computer Operations Department, Company, in accordance with Section 18.19 of the Clerical Agreement, proposes to extend the existing classification of Office Machine Repairman, Customer Accounting, to the Computer Operations Department. The equipment includes three Form Detachers, one Decolorator and an Automated Tape Library and Retrieval System.

Company further proposes to reclassify Mr. Paul J. Martin, Machine Operator A, to the classification of Office Machine Repairman, as proposed above, without reference to the bidding procedure set forth in Title 18 of the Clerical Agreement. Mr. Martin is the top prebidder to the MOX classification.

The wage rate will be the same as that of the Office Machine Repairman, Customer Accounting.
