Gentlemen:

Reference is made to my letter of April 9, 1975 to the United States Department of Labor, Labor-Management Services Administration to the attention of Mr. George Sakanari. The purpose of that letter was to propose to the Department of Labor a resolution of the veteran's reemployment claim made by Mr. Frank D. King, Gas Meter Shopmen, San Francisco Division.

I am informed by Mr. Sakanari that the proposal is acceptable to the Department, and after further discussion with Mr. King, that it is acceptable to him also. This matter has been previously discussed with Mr. John Wilder and is agreeable to him also.

Therefore, pursuant to the provisions of Section 205.19 of the current Physical Labor Agreement, the Company proposes to place Mr. King in a permanent Gas Meter Repairman classification at the San Francisco headquarters.
