Dear Mr. Dean:

The Company and Union met to discuss revisions to Letter Agreement 19-16, concerning relevant criteria for the appropriate rate of pay for employees who accept a Title 200 Apprentice Fitter-Arc position.

The parties agree to modify the criteria by adding a provision for employees who previously held the Title 300 Construction Operator-GC Classification. This Agreement will also incorporate modifications pursuant to Pre-Review Committee #25063 which states: "any bidder who first meets the criteria of the wage placement by holding a Title 200 Fieldperson, Title 300 Construction Operator, or an employee higher in the line of progression who formerly held the classification of either Title 200 Fieldperson or Title 300 Fieldperson-GC Gas will be placed at their current progression step."

This revision will replace Item B in the Notes Section for the Apprentice Fitter Arc Classification, in the Gas T&D Line of Progression with the next scheduled update to the Job Definitions and Lines of Progression (JDLOP). This modification will be effective on a going forward basis. The provision will be as follows:

A Title 200 Fieldperson, Title 300 Construction Operator-GC Gas or an employee in a classification higher in the Line of Progression who formerly held the classification of Fieldperson or Title 300 Construction Operator-GC Gas who is the successful bidder on a vacancy in the Apprentice Fitter-Arc classification will be placed at their current progression step. An employee who enters the Apprentice Fitter-Arc classification after January 1, 2014 will be required to complete the entire 36-month apprentice training program pursuant to Letter Agreement 14-22.

This agreement has been reviewed by Anthony Brown, Senior Assistant Business Manager and Mike Adayan, Assistant Business Manager.
