Gentlemen:

The retirement of a Clerk B in the Topock office in Pipe Line Operations has made it necessary to reassign some job duties among existing employees and to provide employees qualified for promotion to Compressor Plant Operator and Senior Compressor Plant Operator.

Therefore, pursuant to Section 204.4 of the Physical Agreement, Company proposes to establish a Utility Compressor Operator classification at Topock and to assign Mr. John E. Tayloe, presently a Compressor Plant Operator at Topock, on an incumbent-only basis to this classification.

1568 Utility Compressor Operator (incumbent-only)

An employee who performs various clerical assignments, routine duties in the Materials Facility and in addition performs the duties of Compressor Plant Operator as assigned. Hours of work for this classification will be 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., with one-half hour for lunch, Monday through Friday.
