Gentlemen:

As a result of an industrial back injury sustained in 1973, Mr. Harold R. Baggs, T&D Driver in Fresno, has been limited to various light duty assignments not requiring repeated bending, stooping, or heavy lifting. Mr. Baggs' condition is now stationary and rateable, and he can perform the duties of a Street Light Maintenanceman.

Accordingly, pursuant to Sections 205.19 and 206.13 of the Physical Agreement, Company proposes to place Mr. Baggs into a vacant Street Light Maintenanceman position in Fresno. Company also proposes that he be permitted to retain his present bidding rights to the classification of Assistant Foreman's Clerk in the Fresno headquarters. These special bidding rights will become void should Mr. Baggs voluntarily withdraw his prebid or decline an award to an Assistant Foreman's Clerk vacancy in Fresno.

It is our understanding that the Union Business Representative serving Fresno is in accord with this proposal.
