Gentlemen:

This letter supersedes and cancels our letter to you of February 2, 1976, on the same subject.

It has become necessary to establish a Saturday work schedule for Gas Transmission Technicians in Pipe Line Operations at Kettleman in order to perform maintenance on the West Valley microwave system. This change will provide a period of overall testing of Communication facilities on a systemwide basis with a minimum of interference with other activities.

Accordingly, Company proposes, pursuant to Subsection 202.16(b) of the Physical Agreement, to establish a Tuesday through Saturday work schedule on the first and third weeks of each month, excluding the first Saturday of January and September. In addition, Company proposes to schedule two Technicians to work on the second Saturday in April due to the need to coordinate work scheduled on this day elsewhere in the system. Company further proposes to alternate the Saturday work among all qualified Technicians who are at the Kettleman location including any that may be added in the future.

If you are in accord with the foregoing and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided below and return one executed copy of this letter to Company.
