Gentlemen:

This letter supersedes our letter of June 28, 1976 on the same subject.

As a result of the 1972 Materials Department negotiations, most of the Heavy Truck Drivers in the Materials Department were reclassified to Materials Leadman. At that time, Mr. R. E. Dodson, Heavy Truck Driver, Fresno, did not wish to be reclassified. It is our understanding that he has since changed his mind. Further, a recent analysis of Mr. Dodson's duties has demonstrated that it would be to both Mr. Dodson's and Company's advantage to reclassify him to Materials Leadman at this time.

Therefore, Company proposes, effective July 1, 1976, to reclassify Mr. Dodson to Materials Leadman, Classification No. 1086 at \$305.90 per week under the provisions of Section 205.19 of the Agreement.
