Gentlemen:

To preclude the future need for the numerous letters of agreement written to provide three-day holidays for the employees who operate the "Pony Express" system, Company proposes the following:

Company will reschedule the basic workweek of the Mail Clerk Drivers, Clerks and Light Truck Drivers, assigned to this function, where such change will enable Company to grant extended holidays without the payment of overtime, on those holdidays which occur in conjunction with weekends.

Company will give Union 30 days' notice of its intent, when for operating reasons it decides not to reschedule the basic workweek as provided above, for any given holiday.

If you are in accord with the foregoing and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided below and return one executed copy of this letter to Company.
