As a result of an old industrial injury, Mr. B. L. Witherell, a Gas Serviceman in Healdsburg, can no longer perform the duties of the Serviceman classification. He is, however, the senior bidder on a Service Operator classification in San Rafael and is physically able to perform the duties of this classification.

Accordingly, Company proposes to waive the residence requirements contained in Section 3.5 of the Physical Agreement and place Mr. Witherell into a vacant Service Operator position in San Rafael.
