Gentlemen:

This letter cancels and supersedes our letter dated December 17, 1976, on the same subject.

In April of 1977, Company plans to combine the Antioch and Pittsburg Customer Services offices in a new facility to be constructed on Delta Fair and Buchanan Roads in Antioch. It is anticipated that the building will be completed in April 1977, and the actual physical consolidation will occur at that time.

In order to facilitate this eventual relocation, Company proposes to merge the two groups on paper, effective March 1, 1977, and consider the Pittsburg and Antioch offices as one for the purposes of all relevant contractual matters.

This agreement will expire on July 1, 1977, or at the time the consolidation actually takes place, whichever occurs first.

This proposal has been discussed with Mr. R. L. Dunkin, of your staff, and has his tentative approval.
