Following the implementation of Letter Agreement No. 17-20, the Company and IBEW have met to discuss the need to once again staff positions at the Caribou Powerhouse. Many of the vacancies will be filled by employees who either moved from the Caribou location to Rock Creek or who support the Caribou area from Rock Creek.

Given the above, the parties are in agreement to cancel Letter Agreement No. 17-20 and implement the staffing related provisions below to preserve the priority bidding rights of those impacted by LA No. 17-20 and to provide for continuity of service to the company and employee job assignments.

The specific one-time process to staff the Caribou location as detailed below:

- The Company will submit vacancies at the Caribou Headquarters no later than March 31, 2023.
- Any vacancy with a control date before March 31, 2023 will be filled in the following sequence:
 - Preferential bidding rights will be provided to those at Rock Creek who were relocated under LA 17-20 and have priority return bidding rights to Caribou under Section 205.7 of the agreement.
 - Offers will then be extended in accordance with Section 205.7 (b) of the agreement but only to those employees headquartered at Rock Creek who directly support the Caribou Area of Responsibility.
 - Should any vacancies remain open, they will be filled by utilization of the remaining provisions of Section 205.7, beginning with 205.7(b) bidders outside of Rock Creek Powerhouse.

The above applies only to vacancies submitted before March 31, 2023. Any vacancy with a control date after March 31, 2023 will be subject to the agreed to regular provisions of Section 205.7

In addition to the above, the Company agrees to initial staffing levels of 10 Operator positions at each of the locations.
