Gentlemen:

Company proposes to amend Paragraph C.3 of the 'NOTES ON THE ASSIGNMENT OF T & D WORK" contained in the Electric Department Job Definitions - Exhibit VI-L, Page 19, of the Agreement dated September 1, 1952, as amended. We propose the following amended paragraph:

> 3. Employees in appropriate Gas Department classifications may be required to trench, install ducts, cable in conduit (C.I.C.), direct burial cable, manholes, splice boxes, vaults, etc., and tamp and backfill. When C.I.C. is installed, the ends of the cable will be left in a predetermined position (not connected). When direct burial cable is installed, the ends of the cable will be left in a predetermined position (not connected), which includes inserting the cable through the service riser in a residence, leaving the cable extending from the meter socket or service termination enclosure and inserting the cable in a splice box. Such work may also be performed by overhead crews or by an Electric Department labor crew which may include a Lineman and a working Foreman.
