Gentlemen:

Since the wage rate for the Assistant First Operator classification at Oakland Power Plant has been changed to a rate equal to the rate for Substation First Operators, Schedule II, Company proposes to amend the job definition of Assistant First Operator - Power Plants, which was effective February 1, 1959, to read as follows:

ASSISTANT FIRST OPERATOR - POWER PLANTS

A shift employee who, under the direction of a First Operator, performs switching, tends equipment, keeps records, controls generating equipment and voltage levels and assists the First Operator.

An Emergency Relief Assistant First Operator is an Assistant First Operator at Oakland Power Plant whose primary duties are to stand shifts as assigned, relieve other Assistant First Operators and relieve First Operators in Schedules II or III substations and Second Operators at any substation. In addition, he may be required to perform routine electrical, mechanical and building maintenance at such locations.
