Company has reviewed the rating of the Rock Creek Powerhouse Operators with respect to the changes in equipment, function, duties and responsibilities which have occurred due to the reconstruction of facilities on the Feather River.

As a result, Company proposes to rerate the First Operators and Emergency Relief Operators at Rock Creek Powerhouse from Scheule II with a wage rate of \$131.40 per week to Schedule I with a wage rate of \$135.15 per week to be effective as of March 1, 1962.
