Gentlemen:

This letter supersedes our proposed letter agreement dated July 1, 1968, on the same subject.

Company proposes to establish the classification of Lead Field Garage Mechanic in General Construction with a wage rate of \$190.40 per week. Company expects to use this classification when more than one Field Garage Mechanic A or B, who is reporting to the same department, is assigned to the same field headquarters and no supervisor is present during the work hours during which the two or more employees are working together. The employee in charge in such a situation, during work periods starting between noon and midnight, will be classified as a Lead Field Garage Mechanic.

If you are in accord with the foregoing proposal and agree thereto, please so indicate in the space provided below and return one executed copy of this letter to Company.
