The following will further clarify our understanding with respect to the establishment of the Routine Clerical Assistant and Clerical Assistant classifications. It is proposed that this understanding will supplement our letter of agreement dated May 1, 1968.

Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 311.7, employees transferred to such classifications from any other part of Company's system who prior to such transfer have qualified for a vacation under the provisions of Title 211, shall continue to accrue vacation entitlement in the manner provided by Title 211 of said Agreement.
