Gentlemen:

The Company proposes to participate in a work experience/education program sponsored by the Emeryville Unified School District and the Emeryville Industries Association. Basically the program provides for regular part-time employment of high school students during the school year.

We propose to employ two male high school students on a regularly scheduled, four-hour, part-time basis. The present plan would be to establish a schedule of work hours from 12:30 PM to 4:30 PM, Monday through Friday. The students would be classified as Utility Aide and would be assigned to clean-up details, such as sweeping the yard, cleaning windows, and other related house-keeping duties. We propose to establish a wage scale of \$2.00 per hour for the students appointed to such classification at the Emeryville headquarters. These students would qualify for regular status in the manner provided by the Physical Labor Agreement for part-time employees.

We intend to review this program at the conclusion of the school year and may propose at that time to continue them at the same rate of pay on a full-time basis during the summer school vacation period or hire additional students on an additional four-hour, part-time schedule.
