Gentlemen:

Members of the General Construction gas crew headquartered at the Topock Compressor Station at Needles are on a 10 and 4 work schedule in order that they may return to their homes on their non-work days. Their regular hours of work are 8:00 AM to 4:30 PM.

As an accommodation to the members of this crew to permit them earlier departure on the 10th consecutive work day, it is proposed that the regular hours of work on their 10th work day be changed to 4:00 AM to 12:30 PM with one-half hour for lunch, under the provisions of Section 302.7 of the Agreement.

It is our understanding that this matter has been discussed with your representative, Mr. M. D. Harrington, who endorses this request. It is further proposed that this change of hours be effective on February 13, 1969, which is the next 10th work day for this crew, and that such hours of work will continue for as long as the crew is headquartered at Needles.
