Company further proposes that, effective March (2), 1969, no further vacancies in the Lineman classification will be filled on a provisional basis as outlined in the letter agreement on training and advancement of Apprentice Linemen dated March 4, 1964, and that the other provisions of that letter agreement will only be effective for those employees in the provisional Lineman classification on March 30, 1969.
