Gentlemen:

Our proposed letter agreement dated February 20, 1957 is hereby with-drawn. In January of this year Company surveyed the duties of the Utilityman classification in the Electric Department at Chico currently held by Mr. H. E. Clark. The former wage rate of \$95.30 per week was established on the following basis: Painter 45%, Finish Carpenter 25%, Rough Carpenter 17% and Pipe Fitter 13%.

As a result of the survey and the general wage increase, effective July 1, 1957, Company proposes to increase the wage rate to \$102.25 per week based on the following breakdown of duties:

Finish Carpenter 57.5% of \$107.30 or \$61.70 Rough Carpenter 22.1% of \$89.65 or \$19.81 Painter 19.3% of \$101.95 or \$19.68 Pipe Fitter 1.1% of \$96.80 or \$1.06
