Gentlemen:

The wage rate of \$75.05 for the Utilityman classification at Kilarc Power House currently held by Mr. Luige Dellaragoine was computed on the following basis: Troubleman 15%, Relief First Operator 20%, Meter Reader 25%, and Laborer 40%.

Based upon a resurvey of the duties of this classification, Company proposes to establish the weekly wage rate of \$80.75 for this classification as follows:

Relief First Operator	69% of \$80.95 or \$55.86
Troubleman	13% of \$95.45 or \$12.41
Helper	10% of \$69.75 or \$ 6.97
Laborer	<u>8% of \$68.40 or \$ 5.47</u>
Utilityman	100% \$80.71
