Gentlemen:

Since the electric generating facility at Oakland Power Plant will be shut down later this spring, Company proposes to establish the classification of "Steam Heat Engineer" in that location for the operation of the boilers which supply commercial steam for sale in downtown Oakland. Company proposes the same job definition and wage rate as are applied at Stations S and T, and proposes to delete the description "(Oakland or Potrero)" as shown in conjunction with "Auxiliary Operator" under the heading "Next Lower Classifications" in Exhibit VI-B to the Agreement dated September 1, 1952.
