Gentlemen:

Messrs. Herbert S. White and Carl Alexander, Senior Service Operators in Selma, were red-circled in their classification under the provisions of the 1966 settlement. For bidding purposes they are considered as a Foreman's Clerk, which provides 205.7(b) rights only in bidding to Foreman's Clerk or Assistant Foreman's Clerk vacancies.

Because of the experience of Mr. White and Mr. Alexander, Company proposes that their bids to fill vacancies in the classification of Service Operator - Fresno Gas or Distribution Operator - Fresno Electric, be considered under the provisions of 205.7(b) and time spent in the Senior Service Operator classification would count as classification seniority in the classification to which they were bidding.
