Gentlemen:

Company will eliminate the classification of Utility Transformer Repairman in the Delta District Electric Department of Stockton Division and will establish the classification of Transformer Repairman in the Division Electric Substation Maintenance Department in Stockton. The weekly wage rates of the two classifications are identical and are as follows:

Start	-	\$119.85
End 6 Mos.	-	\$124.55
End 1 Year	-	\$128.30

Company proposes to reclassify Mr. C. L. Filippini from Utility Transformer Repairman to Transformer Repairman without reference to the bidding procedure under the provisions of Subsection 206.1(e) of the Agreement. Mr. Filippini will be continued at his present rate of \$128.30 per week.
