Gentlemen:

Our proposed letter agreement dated May 21, 1969, is withdrawn.

By letter agreement, dated October 8, 1968, Company and Union agreed to certain special conditions applicable to employees hired following a special training program under the auspices of the Management Council for Bay Area Opportunity. This agreement has the expiration date of June 30, 1969.

During the year beginning July 1, 1969 and ending June 30, 1970, Company plans to hire 26 hard-core unemployed persons - 15 in San Francisco Division, 8 in the Peninsula District of San Jose, and 3 in the Marin and Vallejo-Napa Districts of North Bay Division. We propose to apply the terms of the letter agreement of October 8, 1968 to these employees, and to extend the term of that agreement by one year.
