Company will reassign certain of the Communication Technician positions as follows:

Concord	3 Technicians	4 Technicians
Hayward	1 Technician	3 Technicians

Under the provisions of Sections 205.19 and 206.13 of the Agreement, Company proposes to transfer Messrs. P. E. Oas and T. Browne from 2509 Myrtle Street, Oakland to Hayward, and Mr. S. E. Tollakson from 1625 Clay Street, Oakland to Concord, without reference to the bidding procedure. In addition, Company proposes, under the provisions of Section 202.16 of the Agreement, to establish the following basic workweek schedule for the Communication Technicians following reassignment as proposed above:

- a) Communication Technicians assigned to Myrtle Street, Oakland:
4 Communication Technicians, each working 10 weeks, Monday thru Friday. 11th week, Tuesday thru Saturday on staggered schedule.
- b) Communication Technicians assigned to Concord Service Center:
4 Communication Technicians, each working 10 weeks, Monday thru Friday. 11th week, Tuesday thru Saturday on staggered schedule.
- c) Communication Technicians assigned to Hayward Service Center:
3 Communication Technicians, one working 10 weeks, Monday thru Friday. 11th week, two will be working the following schedule:
11 weeks, Monday thru Friday
12th week, Tuesday thru Saturday
9 weeks, Monday thru Friday
10th week, Tuesday thru Saturday
